Applications are invited from Indian citizens for the post of Research Assistant (01 position) and Field Investigator (03 positions) for the Indian Council of Social Science Research (ICSSR) funded project under IMPRESS Scheme entitled "Hazard Vulnerability and the Political Economy of Livelihood Transformation: Insights from the Indian Sundarban" (IMPRESS/P970/2018-19/ICSSR). This is a project with inter-disciplinary team of researchers, and seeks to contribute to the existing discourse on analysis of hazard vulnerability in the coastal areas.
